Agenda No. SB.44.2 To report and ratify the minutes of the School Board meeting through circulation and the revised Programme Development Form (PDF) and the revised Programme Project Report (PPR) of the Bachelor of Science (Food Safety and Quality Management).

SB.44.2.1 The Chairman apprised the members that the School of Agriculture has circulated one Agenda Item, i.e. "To consider and approve the revised Programme Development Form (PDF) and Programme Project Report (PPR) of the B.Sc. (Food Safety and Quality Management)" on 16.11.2023, through email to all the members of the School Board for consideration and approval.





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The School Board has approved the revised Programme Development Form (PDF) and Programme Project Report (PPR) of the Bachelor of Science (Food Safety and Quality Management) through circulation and the same was submitted to the University's Academic Council's Standing Committee (ACSC) for consideration and approval in its 62nd meeting held on 28.11.2023.

The Minutes of the School Board held through circulation (dated 20.11.2023) along with the revised PDF and PPR of "B.Sc. (Food Safety and Quality Management)" (BSCFSQM) Programme are reported to the School Board Meeting for its confirmation.

The Programme Coordinator Prof. P. Vijayakumar informed the School of Agriculture was developing this programme under the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS). Recently, UGC has notified the Curriculum and Credit Framework for Undergraduate Programmes (CCFUP) for the Four Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUP) and the same have been adopted by the University. Based on the approval of Broad Framework and suggested Programme Structure for 4-year Bachelor's Degree programme in line with the UGC's FYUP in the 80th Academic Council, the programme structure of the B.Sc. in Food Safety and Quality Management (BSCFSQM) was revised as per the new FYUP guidelines in the expert group meeting held on 8th November 2023. The programme structure for the first three years (B.Sc.(Major) in Food Safety and Quality Management) has been finalized and the fourth year course structure (B.Sc. in Food Safety and Quality Management - Honours/Honours with Research) will be developed later based on the University guidelines.

SB.44.2.2 **The School Board noted and confirmed the minutes of the School Board meeting through circulation.**

SB.44.2.3 **The School Board noted the revised Programme Development Form (PDF) and the revised Programme Project Report (PPR) of the Bachelor of Science (Food Safety and Quality Management) and approved the same. (Appendix-2).**

Agenda No. SB.44.3 **To consider and approve the revised Programme Development Form (PDF) and Programme Project Report (PPR) of Diploma in Animal Husbandry (DAH).**

SB.44.3.1 Dr. Mita Sinhamahapatra, Programme Coordinator, presented this agenda item and explained that the School of Agriculture is developing a Diploma Programme in Animal Husbandry (DAH). Earlier the DAH programme was designed with 32 credits. As per the new UGC guidelines, the School proposes to revise the programme structure of the DAH to have 40 credits. Thus, an Expert Committee meeting was convened on 01.12.2023 to revise the programme structure with 40 credits. She presented the revised PDF and PPR of DAH programme along with the revised Programme Structure. The revised programme structure comprising following 8 courses:

- Course-1 : Basics of Veterinary and Animal Sciences (2+0): (Theory)
- Course-2 : Livestock Production and Management (6+0): (Theory)
- Course-3 : Basics of Animal Reproduction (6+0): (Theory)
- Course-4 : Common Diseases and Prevention (4+0): (Theory)
- Course-5 : Animal Husbandry Extension and Farm Economics (2+0): (Theory)
- Course-6 : Common Livestock Management Practices (0+8): (Practical)
- Course-7 : Animal reproduction (0+6): (Practical)
- Course-8 : Animal Health care (0+6): (Practical)

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SB.44.3.2 After detailed discussions, the School Board approved the revised Programme Development Form (PDF) and Programme Project Report (PPR) of Diploma in Animal Husbandry (DAH) (Appendix-3).

Agenda No. SB.44.4 To consider and approve the Programme Proposal Form (PPF) of Master of Business Administration (Agribusiness Management).

SB.44.4.1 Prof. P. K. Jain, Programme Coordinator, presented this agenda item and apprised the members that the School of Agriculture is proposing to start a Master of Business Administration (Agribusiness Management) programme and explained its salient features. He informed that an Exploratory Expert Committee Meeting was held on 30th November 2023 in which the experts unanimously agreed that there is a huge demand for MBA (Agribusiness Management) from the different stakeholders of agriculture including corporates. The broad outline of the program was finalized in the meeting. The PPF of the program was submitted as an Annexure to the agenda of this item for consideration and approval.

The detailed discussions were held regarding the Programme Proposal Form (PPF) of the MBA (Agribusiness Management). One of the members suggested keeping the title of this programme as MBA (Food & Agribusiness Management) in place of the MBA (Agribusiness Management). It is suggested that the issue shall be discussed in the next Expert Committee Meeting of the programme while designing the detail programme structure.

SB.44.4.2 After detailed discussions, the School Board approved the Programme Proposal Form (PPF) of Master of Business Administration (Agribusiness Management) (Appendix-4).

Agenda No. SB.44.5 To consider and approve the names of Unit writers and Course Editors for "B.Sc. (Food Safety and Quality Management)" (BSCFSQM) Programme.

SB.44.5.1 The Programme Coordinator presented this agenda item and informed the Board that the School is developing B.Sc. in Food Safety and Quality Management programme and has restructured the curriculum as per the new FYUP UGC guidelines. Accordingly, the School has identified unit writers and editors for various courses of Semester 1 and 2. The list of the identified unit writers and course editors for "B.Sc. in Food Safety and Quality Management" (BSCFSQM) Programme was placed as an Annexure to the agenda of this item for consideration and approval.

SB.44.5.2 The School Board approved the names of Unit writers and Course Editors for "B.Sc. (Food Safety and Quality Management)" (BSCFSQM) Programme (Appendix-5).

Agenda No. SB.44.6 To consider and approve the revised eligibility criteria for admission in the M. Sc in Food Safety and Quality Management (MSCFSQM) and PG Diploma in Food Safety and Quality Management (PGDFSQM) programme.

SB.44.6.1 Dr. Mita Sinhamahapatra, Programme Coordinator apprised the Board members that the School is offering M.Sc. in Food Safety and Quality Management (MSCFSQM) programme which is an upgradation of the PG Diploma in Food Safety and Quality Management (PGDFSQM) programme; and PG diploma is an entry and exit point for MSCFSQM.



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As the existing eligibility criteria for both the programmes are different and there were few queries seeking the clarification of the eligibility criteria for the MSCFSQM during last two admission cycles, she proposed the same revised eligibility criteria for both the programmes in order to avoid the ambiguity.

Revised eligibility criteria for MSCFSQM and PGDFSQM:

- a) Graduation in science/tech in Food Safety & Quality Management/ Agriculture/ Food Science/Food tech/ Engineering having chemistry and microbiology subjects/Post Harvest Technology/ Home Science/ Life Science/ Microbiology/ chemistry/ Biochemistry/ Biotechnology/ Pharmacy/ Medical Lab tech/ Horticulture/ Dairy Technology/ Veterinary/ Fisheries/ Medical/ Dental Sc./ Nursing/ BAMS/ BHMS/ Hotel Management and Catering etc.
- b) PG Diploma in Food Safety and Quality Management (lateral entry for 2nd year of M. Sc). These diploma holders should also have one of the qualifications mentioned at (a). Who have completed 32 credits will also have to complete one additional project work/industrial training report/food testing lab training of 4 credits in the second year.

SB.44.6.2 After detailed deliberations, the School Board approved the revised eligibility criteria for admission in the M.Sc. in Food Safety and Quality Management (MSCFSQM) and PG diploma in Food Safety and Quality Management (PGDFSQM) programme.

Agenda No. SB.44.7 To consider and approve the additional list of evaluators for M.Sc. in Food Safety and Quality Management (MSCFSQM) and PG diploma in Food Safety and Quality Management (PGDFSQM) programme.

SB.44.7.1 Dr. Mita Sinhamahapatra, Programme Coordinator informed that the School is offering M.Sc in Food Safety and Quality Management (MSCFSQM) programme which is an upgradation of the PG Diploma in Food Safety and Quality Management (PGDFSQM) programme. As new courses have been added in the second year of the MSCFSQM and the course code of project work in PGDFSQM has been changed, the School requires more evaluators for the courses (theory, project and dissertation) of these two programmes. She presented an additional list of evaluators of these two programmes.

SB.44.7.2 After discussion, the School Board approved the additional list of evaluators for M.Sc in Food Safety and Quality Management (MSCFSQM) and PG diploma in Food Safety and Quality Management (PGDFSQM) programme (Appendix-6).

Agenda No. SB.44.11 To consider and approve the Evaluation of practical of BAPI-002 and BAPI-003 courses taken by the learners of Bachelor's Degree Programme of the University.

SB.44.11.1 Prof. S. K. Yadav, Programme Coordinator, presented this agenda item and explained that the University has put two courses of Certificate in Organic Farming (COF) programme, namely BAPI-002 and BAPI-003, in the basket of Skill Enhancing Courses (SEC) of Bachelor's Degree Programme in its II and III semester. Many learners of Bachelor of Arts (BA) and Commerce (BCOM) have chosen these courses as the Skill Enhancing Courses. These courses are having practical component and for the evaluation of practical component, study centre of COF programme is required.

The learners of bachelor's degree programme are scattered across the country and at many places, the study centre of COF is not available. Since the learners have completed other requirements of the course, except the practical, due to which their degree remained incomplete. In order to enable the learners to complete this course and also the degree successfully, the Regional Centres having Study Centres of COF programme were requested to accommodate the learners at the Study Centre to get their practical evaluation done. But the places where the Study Centres of COF programme are not there, the learners were directed to prepare a report on the practical exercises and send it to the School of Agriculture for evaluation. The evaluated marks were sent to Student Evaluation Division for the completion of the degree of the learners. These courses have mostly the exercises based on field visits and project development.

The proposal for evaluating the practical component of BAPI-002 and BAPI-003 courses for the Bachelor's Degree programme learners through report on Practical is submitted to the School Board for consideration and approval.


Agenda No. SB.44.17 To report the names of the members of the Expert Committee for revision of Diploma in Animal Husbandry (DAH) programme.
