- SB.45.2.1 Prof. P. K. Jain, Programme Coordinator, presented this agenda item and apprised the Board that the School is developing a Master of Business Administration (Agribusiness Management) programme. The Exploratory Expert Group meeting was held on 30.11.2023. The Expert Group Meeting was convened on 15.05.2024 to crystallize the need of the programme, title of the programme, objectives of the programme, target group, eligibility for enrolment (Minimum qualifications) and programme structure (credits load and the number of courses).

The programme will have the broad structure of the IGNOU MBA programme. The first year's courses will be adopted as such from the IGNOU MBA programme. The School will develop the second year courses with agribusiness specialization. The programme will be of a total of 116 credits comprising of 27 theory courses of 4 credits each and one project of 8 credits. The minimum eligibility for the programme shall be graduation in any discipline as per the IGNOU MBA programme.

The School Board of the School of Agriculture (44<sup>th</sup> meeting Agenda item 44.4 held on 08.12.2023) and Academic Programme Committee (APC) (70<sup>th</sup> meeting Agenda 70.6 held on 30.01.2024) have approved the Programme Proposal Form (PPF) of the programme.

The members suggested a few topics to be included in the syllabus. The Programme Coordinator informed that the syllabus already includes the suggested topics.
